Note:

Projects 100139, 100144, 100145, 100146, 100148, 100149, 100150, 100152, 100153, 100154, 100155, 100156, 100157, 100158, 100160, 100161, 100666, 100667, 100709, 100710, and 100768 were related to the STEP Project (IP26020401-Business Process Efficiency Project). This was an American Water Systemwide Project to replace billing and accounting software. The project numbers above (100147, 100159, 100122, and 100757 were part of the overall project, were completed and are in service and included in the rate base requested in this case. The remainder of the projects were originally charged to CWIP but not completed. Those projects have now been canceled. The charges were written off to expense in 2005 and 2006. As noted in response to the TRA data request 1 question 13, the work papers detail the elimination of this write off in the amount of \$351,832 on page TN-TRA-01-Q013-Misc Expenses Page 4 of 8. This amount was eliminated from account 6758 miscellanous office expense. This was also referenced on page 13 of the testimony of Sheila Miller. Those one-time write-offs were eliminated from both the historical test-year and attrition year filed in this case and no rate recovery is being requested for those items.
