**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Vice Chairman Robin L. Morrison, Director Herbert H. Hilliard and Director Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on March 13, 2017. An Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide competing local telecommunications services in Tennessee, including exchange access, was filed by OneTone Telecom, Inc. ("OneTone" or the "Company") on December 12, 2006. During a Hearing held on January 25, 2007, the Hearing Officer found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On October 14, 2016, the Authority received a request from OneTone to cancel its CCN. OneTone stated that it is no longer doing business in Tennessee. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its CCN.¹
