Dear Director Roberson:

During the January 23, 2007 agenda conference, you asked when AT&T would begin offering broadband Internet service in Tennessee for \$10 per month.

A copy of AT&T's December 28 letter to the FCC describing its voluntary agreements in connection with the AT&T/BellSouth merger was filed with the TRA in Docket No. 06-00093 on January 9, 2007. As described in the December 28 letter, AT&T will offer a \$10 per month broadband Internet access service to AT&T retail consumers in Tennessee, as well as other AT&T in-region states, by June 29, 2007. This broadband Internet access service will provide speeds up to 768Kbps, and will be offered to retail consumers who have not previously subscribed to AT&T or BellSouth ADSL service. The service will be available in AT&T's broadband wireline buildout area as defined in the December 28 letter. The offer will continue for at least 30 months after its inception. Additional information regarding this merger commitment can be found in the December 28 letter.
