On July 11, 2007, Lynwood Utility Corporation (Lynwood) and the Tennessee Attorney General and Reporter through the Consumer Advocate and Protection Division submitted a Proposed Settlement Agreement on the above-captioned Petition of Lynwood for a rate increase.


By this letter Lynwood requests that the Authority place this Proposed Settlement Agreement for consideration on the Authority Conference Agenda for August 13, 2007. The rates proposed by Lynwood upon the filing of the Petition have been suspended until August 3, 2007, which is the end of the six months period referenced in T.C.A. § 65-5-103(b) for the Authority to review Lynwood's rate increase request.

Lynwood is willing to waive its statutory right under T.C.A. § 65-5-103(b) to put the proposed rate increase into effect for ten (10) days until August 13, 2007, provided the above-captioned Petition is heard at the August 13, 2007, Authority Conference and that the rate increase approved by the Authority is allowed to go into effect immediately.
