
This letter shall serve as notice to the Authority that the Company received no telephone calls about odor complaints from January 1, 2008 through March 31, 2008. The Company received no written complaints at its office about odor from January 1, 2008 through March 31, 2008.

The Company received notice on March 10, 2008, of a complaint filed by Kacie Fitzpatrick-Dunavan with the Authority which included a petition signed by 40 customers of the Company expressing concern about the smells coming from the Company's sewer treatment plant. The Company filed a response to this complaint on March 24, 2008, by letter to Carsie Mundy.
