Mr. Cox,

Thanks for your response. My only question still is that you did not state that lot 34 will never be used. You stated it is not included in the plan for the system at this time. I have to know that lot 34 will never be used as part of the utility. I hope you can truly understand my feelings. It is going to hurt my resale value of my home and no matter what quanics states I still feel there is going to be some smell from the drip system. I can't see how there would not be some. I feel that it will restrict me as a homeowner on what I could do in my own yard. I would not feel comfortable planting a garden on the left side of my home which is the side closest to lot 34 knowing that sewage was being absorbed in the ground. I know Mr. Tipton owns the lot next to my home - well that is what the tax records state. Would lot 34 be able to house the individual home system that you are proposing and then connect to the larger system? If so, Mr. Tipton can sale that lot to a homeowner. If it will not be able to house the individual system I would be glad to speak to him to see if I could purchase the lot so he is not out any money. I hope Mr. King that currently owns all of the space in question can understand my concerns as well. If he is willing to house the whole system (including any future growth) within the area currently proposed on the map you sent me I think I'm fine with that. I hope he plans on trying to hide it by trees. I did go on the Quanics website the other day and see pictures of the systems. From the photos is shows that the tanks will be visible above ground. I am not sure if that was just to show people what the system looks like or if it is buried under ground. Can you answer that question? I do appreciate you taking the time to address all of my questions.

I received a copy of an e-mail on February 20, 2007 from Ms. Overton sent to Mr. Jeffrey Cox on February 19, 2007 concerning a wastewater treatment center being located in close proximity to her home. I also received a voice mail from her requesting that I call her. I could not understand the phone number on the voice mail so I sent her an e-mail requesting her to please call me back. Ms. Overton explained her situation to me and I indicated to her that the soil approvals would come from the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation ("TDEC"). She also expressed to me that the bylaws of her subdivision had restrictions and that a wastewater treatment center being installed next to her home would violate these restrictions. She stated that she had called the City Planning Commission and they suggested she call the TRA. I then explained that the TRA would be holding a Public Hearing for the approval of a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") and that she would be welcomed to appear and make public comment. I also told her that I would have to file a copy of the e-mail she had copied me to this docket file (07-00008). She indicated that it would be ok to go ahead and file it.

Mr. Cox,

I have a few questions in reference to the proposed sewer system. First of all I don't understand if the current empty lots need this in order to build why do they not place the system in that area. Is there a good reason why this system can not be placed in that area? I was told by my neighbors that the lot next to my home will not perk. So, if it does not perk and the empty lots do not perk why not place it in the area that needs the system? It looks like they should be willing to make a sacrifice since they are the property owners that need the system and not me. When I bought my home last year nothing was disclosed to me in writing by the seller that this was going to be placed next to my home even though this was already in the works before I purchased my home - I did not find out until later when I googled my subdivision name - what a surprise I found. Can you please tell me about the system you are proposing and where the exhaust pipe will be placed. Also, our subdivision regulations states nothing in reference to having a sewer system like yours in our neighborhood. It states only (1) single-family residence may be constructed one each lot. Have you spoken to all of the current homeowners of the neighborhood to get this approved? The current subdivision regulations run for a period of ten (10) years and shall automatically renew unless a document signed by two-thirds of the owners is recorded. The current regulations was signed on September 15, 2000. My former employer is a Geologist for a company in the Knoxville area and I am forwarding him your proposed plan for him to review. Also, my cousins take soil samples in the general area and have stated to me that their are several neighborhood sewer system on their route and when it rains the smell is awful. They were not sure when these systems were

installed but warned me of the awful smell after a rain. How do you propose to eliminate this? You are proposing to place this system between two homes and also located behind this lot is acres that they are use to grow crops. How is your system going to affect us?I hope you can understand my concern for my resale value. I look forward to your response.
