**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman James M. Allison, Director Kenneth C. Hill and Director Sara Kyle of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority" or "TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on February 13, 2013. Conversant Technologies, Inc. ("Conversant" or the "Company") originally filed an Application for authority to provide operator services and resell local and interexchange long distance telecommunications services in Tennessee on February 8, 2007. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on April 16, 2007, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On October 23, 2012, the TRA received a request from Conversant to cancel its authority.¹ Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.²

IT IS SO ORDERED.
