**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE  
CUSTOMER OWNED COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE**

This matter came before Chairman James M. Allison, Director Kenneth C. Hill and Director Sara Kyle of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority" or "TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on December 17, 2012. Conversant Technologies, Inc. ("Conversant" or the "Company") originally filed an Application to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") service within the State of Tennessee on February 12, 2007. During an Authority Conference held on March 12, 2007, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-2-.43 through 1220-4-2-.45 to provide COCOT service in Tennessee and approved the Application.<sup>1</sup> On October 23, 2012, the TRA received a request from Conversant to cancel its authority. Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to cancel, by request, the authority of Conversant Technologies, Inc. to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.
