RE: ACA Tariff Filing for RBS Gas Utility Inc.

Dear Chairman Kyle:

Enclosed please find an original and four (4) copies of an ACA tariff filing for RBS Gas Utility Company ("RBS"). I am making this filing under my authority as president of Receivership Management, Inc. ("RMI"), the court-appointed receiver for RBS. This tariff filing is made as authorized and provided for under the applicable statutes and rules of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "TRA"). I request that this filing have an effective date of February 26, 2007.

In addition to the above request, I am also asking that the TRA waive the thirty (30) day notice requirement for this tariff filing, pursuant to Rule 1220-4-1-.03 of the TRA. As you know, on May 19, 2006, RBS was placed into receivership as a result of an action filed by the TRA in the Chancery Court for Macon County. A plan to sell the assets of RBS to Community Initiative was approved by the Court and the rates filed by Community Initiative approved by the TRA earlier this month. However the franchise agreement required as a condition of the TRA approval was not granted by the City of Red Boiling Springs. Therefore, it is necessary for me to file the ACA to recover from the customers of RBS the costs for gas used but not paid for by those customers. While the proposed sale was pending, the ACA filing has been held in abeyance. However, it is now necessary to go forward with this filing as the first step in providing the Court with a rehabilitation plan rather than a sale. It is on this basis the TRA is urged to grant RBS a waiver of the thirty (30) day notice requirement. As a further note, the ACA filing is based on recovery over a four year rather than a one year period. This is necessary in order to try to make the cost of gas to the RBS customer close to the estimated cost of propane. In addition to this ACA filing, I plan on filing for a new base rate as soon as possible in order to reflect current operating costs. If any rehabilitation plan has a chance to work, it must strike a balance between the costs to operate the system and allow a plan to pay the current debt.
