Re: *Complaint of BLC Management LLC dba Angles Communication Solutions Against BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. to Resolve Billing Disputes, Enforce the Parties' Interconnection Agreement, and Prevent Interference with Service to Customers*

Dear Chairman Kyle:

Late yesterday afternoon, Angles filed a *Complaint*. In that *Complaint*, Angles claims it has paid all undisputed amounts owed to BellSouth. Angles requests that the TRA "...resolve this billing dispute and that, pending the outcome of this Complaint, the TRA order the parties to maintain the status quo".<sup>1</sup>

This letter is to notify the Authority that BellSouth disputes the allegations set forth in Mr. Walker's letter and Complaint. Angles is delinquent, and has been delinquent for months, in its payment to BellSouth for undisputed amounts owed. However, BellSouth is willing to meet with representatives of Angles in an attempt to resolve this dispute. BellSouth agrees that it will not terminate service prior to this meeting provided that a meeting is conducted promptly. BellSouth has no objection to members of the Authority Staff attending the meeting. Moreover, contrary to Angles' claim, BellSouth does not intend to take any action on February 28 that would result in the termination of telephone service to end user customers. Given this agreement by BellSouth, there is no need for the Authority to take any action on February 26 during its Agenda Conference.


