ORDER APPOINTING A HEARING OFFICER

This matter came before Chairman Sara Kyle, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Pat Miller of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on April 30, 2007 for consideration of the request filed on April 27, 2007 by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Tennessee ("BellSouth") asking the Authority to appoint a Hearing Officer in this docket. On February 22, 2007, BLC Management, LLC d/b/a Angles Communication Solutions ("Angles") filed a complaint against BellSouth regarding an unresolved billing dispute between BellSouth and Angles. On February 23, 2007 and March 26, 2007, BellSouth filed responses to Angles' complaint. On April 30, 2007, Angles filed a response to BellSouth's April 27, 2007 request for appointment of a Hearing Officer.

During the April 30, 2007 Authority Conference, the panel voted unanimously to appoint the Authority's General Counsel or his designee to act as the Hearing Officer in this matter to make findings of fact and conclusions of law, as necessary, and to render an initial decision on the merits of the complaint pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-5-223 and such other legal authority as may be provided by law. Also, the panel instructed the Hearing Officer to discuss customer notification requirements that may be needed if customers are disconnected. Additionally, the panel empowered the Hearing Officer to resolve any customer notification issues.
