additional relief as the Authority finds just and appropriate.¹ On February 23, 2007, AT&T responded to the Complaint and disputed the allegations set forth in the letter and Complaint filed by Angles. On March 6, 2007, Angles filed the Affidavit of Steve Watson with CGM LLC Telecom Services which stated that Mr. Watson worked with Angles and he submitted to AT&T, on behalf of Angles, notices of billing disputes and claims for promotional credits and he was responsible for tracking the progress of those filings. BellSouth filed its Answer of BellSouth d/b/a AT&T Tennessee to the Complaint on March 26, 2007. On April 27, 2007, AT&T filed a letter providing an update to the TRA on the meeting and discussions with Angles and alleging that Angles had failed to pay undisputed amounts. AT&T requested that the TRA empower a Hearing Officer during the April 30, 2007 Authority Conference to make decisions to resolve this matter. On April 30, 2007, Angles filed a letter stating that it strongly disputed the allegations made by AT&T and that Angles has been paying all current, undisputed amounts to AT&T. On May 9, 2007, Angles filed the Supplemental Affidavit of Steve Watson. The parties engaged in mediation on May 17, 2007. The mediation did not result in a resolution of this matter. On June 12, 2007, AT&T filed a letter in this docket requesting that the Hearing Officer establish a procedural schedule in this matter. On July 25, 2007, the Hearing Officer issued a Notice of Status Conference and scheduled a status conference on August 2, 2007 for the purposes of establishing a procedural schedule, addressing discovery between the parties, and any other pre-hearing matters, including the issuance of a Protective Order. During the status conference, an agreed procedural schedule was established, including dates for discovery, filing of testimony, and establishing a hearing date in October 2007. On August 21, 2007, the Hearing Officer issued the *Order Establishing a Procedural Schedule*. Thereafter, parties commenced discovery and filed prefiled testimony in this docket.

PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

The Hearing Officer finds that the requested modifications of the procedural schedule by the parties are reasonable and should be granted. The Hearing Officer hereby establishes the Modified Procedural Schedule governing discovery, filing of testimony, and a hearing on the merits in this docket. The Modified Procedural Schedule is attached to this Order as **Exhibit A** and reflects the changes to the date for filing of direct testimony as requested jointly by the parties on September 6, 2007 and the joint request by the parties filed on September 24, 2007 to change the date for the filing of the parties' rebuttal testimony. As with any schedule, the effectiveness of this Modified Procedural Schedule is directly dependent upon the extent of cooperation or delay on the part of the parties in meeting the individual benchmark dates.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

The Modified Procedural Schedule, attached to this Order as **Exhibit A** reflecting the changes requested by the parties, is hereby adopted and is in full force and effect.
