#### Description of Proposed Tariff

This General Subscriber Service Tariff filing is prepared in compliance with the FCC's Sixth Report and Order in CC Docket No. 92-105, which designated "811 as the national abbreviated dialing code to be used by state One Call notification systems for providing advanced notice of excavation activities to underground facility operators in compliance with the Pipeline Safety Improvement Act of 2002 (the Pipeline Safety Act)." One call notification is a communication system established by operators of underground facilities and/or state governments to provide a means for excavators and the general public to notify facility operators in advance of their intent to engage in excavation activities.

811 Call Before You Dig Service ("811") is a three (3) digit local dialing arrangement used for the One Call Center. Callers who dial 811 will be routed to the call center via the local 7 or 10 digit or a toll free "point-to" number selected by the One Call Center. There will be no charge to the end user dialing 811.

The proposed effective date of this filing is March 12, 2007.
