Additionally, please provide a summary of WNA revenue by revenue class calculated using the current approved procedure; also provide comparable detail of the proposed WNA revenue.

**RESPONSE:**

In addition to its general objections, AEC incorporates by reference the objection stated in section II.A of its Objections.

AEC and CAPD have agreed that CAPD's request will be reduced from 10 years to the period 2002 forward, with the understanding that if CAPD identifies a need for additional information in specific areas once the initial responses are received and reviewed, AEC and CAPD will discuss the production of further information.
