**JOINT MOTION FOR SUPPLEMENTAL DISCOVERY
RELATING TO RATE DESIGN**

Stand Energy Corporation (“Stand”) and the Atmos Intervention Group (“AIG”) jointly request that Atmos Energy Corporation (the “Company”) be directed to provide the TRA and the parties a separate monthly cumulative distribution of sales volumes during the test period for each of the Company’s rate schedules. This information can be readily produced; it was furnished by Atmos in the Company’s last case; and it is needed by Stand and AIG to translate their tariff recommendations into specific proposals.

AIG and Stand believe that the parties to this case have agreed in principle to a number of issues in this case, including projected volumes in the test period. Given that agreement, Atmos can now project usage in each customer class and tariff group. That chart – showing the distribution of sales volumes for each rate schedule – is a one-page document that Atmos can readily produce. (Attached to this motion is a copy of the sale distribution produced by Atmos in their last rate case.)

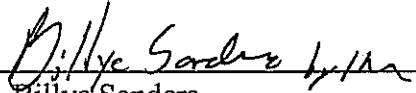
Mr. Novak testified for AIG¹ how rates should be structured but explained that no specific recommendations could be made without additional information. Given the agreement of the parties on sales volumes during the test period, Mr. Novak and Mr. Dosker can now design specific tariffs to present to the Authority once Atmos provides the distribution of sales volumes.

For these reasons, Stand and AIG respectfully request that the Hearing Officer direct Atmos to provide the requested information as soon as practicable.
