**PETITION TO INTERVENE OF ATMOS INTERVENTION GROUP**

The Atmos Intervention Group (“AIG”)<sup>1</sup> petitions the Authority to intervene as a matter of right in the above-captioned proceeding pursuant to T.C.A. §4-5-301.

AIG is an informal group of customers who purchase natural gas and/or gas transportation services from Atmos Energy Corporation (“Atmos”).


This proceeding will address, among other things, the terms and conditions under which AIG members purchase natural gas or gas transportation services. Therefore, the legal rights, duties, privileges, immunities, or other legal interests of AIG’s members may be affected or determined by the outcome of this proceeding. Granting this petition will not impair the interests of justice or the orderly and prompt conduct of these proceedings.

AIG, therefore, asks that this petition to intervene be granted.


