
ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENT


This matter came before Chairman Sara Kyle, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Pat Miller of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on June 25, 2007 to consider the Petition for approval of the amendment to the interconnection agreement negotiated between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. and BellSouth Long Distance, Inc.<sup>1</sup> filed on May 10, 2007.<sup>2</sup>

Based upon a review of the amendment, the record in this matter, and the standards for review set forth in 47 U.S.C. § 252, the Directors made findings consistent with those in the *Order Approving the Interconnection Agreement* issued on October 27, 2005 in Docket No. 05-00213 and unanimously granted the Petition.
