TO THE INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT**


This matter came before Director Eddie Roberson, Director Pat Miller and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on June 25, 2007 to consider the Petition for approval of the amendment to the interconnection agreement negotiated between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. and Comcast Phone II, Inc. and Comcast Phone of Tennessee, LLC filed on May 14, 2007.¹

Based upon a review of the amendment, the record in this matter, and the standards for review set forth in 47 U.S.C. § 252, the Directors made findings consistent with those in the *Order Approving the Interconnection Agreement* issued on January 4, 2006 in Docket No. 05-00263 and unanimously granted the Petition.
