

### Dear Chairman Roberson:

This is to notify the Authority that on July 31, 2007, the Florida Public Service Commission ("Florida PSC") voted unanimously to approve its Staff's recommendation to grant AT&T's Motion to Dismiss. The Florida PSC determined that Sprint's Petition seeks enforcement of an alleged right under the AT&T/BellSouth merger commitments, as opposed to an open issue concerning Section 251. The Florida PSC also voted unanimously to adopt the Florida Staff's recommendation to close the docket.

A copy of the Florida PSC's Vote Sheet is enclosed. AT&T Tennessee will submit a copy of the Florida PSC's written order as soon as it becomes available.
