
**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard, Director Robin Bennett and Director James M. Allison of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority" or "TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on November 4, 2014. Applewood Communications Corporation ("Applewood" or the "Company") originally filed an Application for authority to resell interexchange long distance services in Tennessee on June 20, 2007. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on December 15, 2008, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On October 16, 2014, the TRA received a request from Applewood to cancel its authority.¹ Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.
