Please see the attached resolution from the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California revoking the Non-Dominant Interexchange Carrier Certificates of Public Conveniences and Necessity held by twenty companies, of which Addtel Communications is listed, for failure to comply with California PUC Decision 93-05-010, Ordering Paragraph 4.

Response:

Airespring, Inc. sold Addtel in January 1997 to SA Telecomm. Shortly thereafter, SA Telecomm. went in to bankruptcy. They failed to pay some of the taxes and surcharges.
