MOTION REQUESTING TELEPHONIC HEARING

Pursuant to applicable Tennessee Statutes and the Rules and Regulations of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority and Section 253 of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 ("Act"), Dialtone & More, Inc. ("DTM") respectfully requests that the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA") grant to DTM the ability to attend the Hearing in the above-captioned proceeding telephonically via conference call.

In support of this Motion, DTM submits the following:

- 1) The TRA has requested a hearing in the above-captioned proceeding for Wednesday, December 5th, 2007 at 11:00 AM CST.
- 2) Kim Smith, Vice President for DTM, maintains offices in Douglasville, GA.
- 3) Telecom Professionals, Inc., Regulatory Consultants for DTM, maintains offices in Oklahoma City, OK
- 4) Attending the Hearing for the above-captioned proceeding in person would cause undue burden to both Companies by requiring excessive, expedited travel expenses.
- 5) Both Companies are also in the process of closing year end financial records and the absence of key personnel if attendance were to occur would cause a detriment to the operations of both Dialtone & More, Inc. and Telecom Professionals, Inc. during this crucial time of year.
- 6) Granting of the requested telephonic hearing for Wednesday, December 5th, 2007 at 11:00 AM CST would enable both companies to attend and provide the requested information.

DTM respectfully requests that the TRA enter an order granting its attendance for the Hearing in the above-captioned proceeding telephonically via conference call. Award of DTM's certificate of convenience and necessity to operate as a competing telecommunications service provider throughout the State of Tennessee in the service areas of Bell South, GTE, Sprint and any other ILEC that does not enjoy a rural exemption under Section 251(f) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 would promote the public interest by providing high-quality service at competitive prices and by creating greater economic incentives for the development and improvement for all competing providers.
