**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard, Director Kenneth C. Hill and Director Robin Morrison of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on June 20, 2016. An Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide competing local telecommunications services, including facilities-based and resold local exchange, exchange access and interexchange services, in Tennessee was filed by Aero Communications, LLC ("Aero" or the "Company") on July 6, 2007. During a Hearing held on September 13, 2007, the Hearing Officer found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On April 21, 2016, the Authority received a request from Aero to cancel its CCN, stating that it has ceased providing telecommunications services in Tennessee. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its CCN.
