
Dear Darlene:

I am in receipt of your December 6, 2007, letter in this docket. I was not able to discuss this request with Tyler Ring until late this week. Lynwood had not discussed with Tennessee Commerce Bank the feasibility of the bank issuing a letter of credit for \$467,000 for Lynwood for the benefit of the Authority. Mr. Ring indicated that he would make this request of the bank.
