PETITION TO AMEND CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

The Petitioner, Cartwright Creek, LLC (Cartwright Creek or Company), hereby petitions the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (Authority) to amend its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CCN) to expand its service area to include a portion of Williamson County, Tennessee known as the Stillwater Development (Stillwater). In support of its Petition, Cartwright Creek submits the following:

- 1. Stillwater is in the process of obtaining site plan approval in Williamson County. A copy of the proposed service area is attached as Exhibit #1;
- 2. The respective governmental entities of Williamson County have confirmed that they have no intent to own, operate, or provide wastewater treatment services to this area as shown on collective Exhibit #2;
- 3. Cartwright Creek has a \$240,000 Letter of Credit on file with the Authority.

 A copy of Cartwright Creek's Letter of Credit is attached as Exhibit #3;
- 4. Cartwright Creek has a binding letter of intent with the developer of Stillwater, in which Cartwright Creek becomes the owner and operator of the

wastewater treatment system for Stillwater upon completion and construction

of the system. A copy of the Letter of Intent is attached as Exhibit #4;

5. Cartwright Creek will separately petition the Tennessee Department of

Environment and Conservation (TDEC) for a State Operating Permit for the

installation of a regional wastewater system with the capability to serve

Stillwater and other area developments;

6. A five year pro forma income statement for Stillwater is attached as Exhibit

#5;

7. Pre-filed testimony of Bruce Meyer, President of Cartwright Creek, is

attached as Exhibit #6.

WHEREFORE, PETITIONER PRAYS:

1. That the Authority grant its Petition to amend its Certificate of Public

Convenience and Necessity to expand its service area to include a portion of

Williamson County, Tennessee known as the Stillwater Development;







Binding Letter of Intent

- It is the party's intent, (Stillwater Development and the Burns Family) that a Sheaffer System be located on the Burns Property to initially serve the Stillwater Development of 500 units with a capacity of approximately 150,000 gallons/day. The Sheaffer System to be designed to allow future expansion to serve the Burns Development and other properties in the region, with a future capacity of at least 330,000 gallon per day, based on 300 gallons per EDU.
- Sheaffer International will contract with Cartwright Creek, LLC to prepare and submit to TRA an amendment to its existing CCN, (Certificate of Convenience and Necessity) for PGA5 to reflect the Stillwater Development inclusion into PGA5. The treatment system will be as described in item 1 above.
- Stillwater Development & Burns Family mutually agree that the Sheaffer System title, once installed, the land it occupies, and the primary and all secondary irrigation area will be transferred to Cartwright Creek, LLC to own and operate at a mutually agreed upon point in time.
- Stillwater Development shall have Atwell-Hicks to amend its prior Williamson County submittal of the detailed design report, (DDR) and the detailed soils investigation report, (DSIR) to reflect the inclusion of a Sheaffer System to be located on the Burns property.
- Stillwater Development shall retain Sheaffer International, LLC to complete the preliminary engineering and design parameters.
- 6. Payments to proceed:
 - A. \$5000.00 down payment payable to Sheaffer International for preliminary engineering and design parameters
 - B. \$5,000.00 payable to Sheaffer International for the required work and submittal of CCN to the TRA. To be invoiced once submittal is ready for TRA
 - C. In accordance with the established TRA regulations, a \$20,000 upon request from the TRA shall be deposited in a Certificate of Deposit at Pinnacle Bank to be held as collateral for the required TRA financial security.

PRE-FILED TESTIMONY

- 1 Q. Would you state your name for the record, please?
- 2 A. My name is Bruce Meyer.
- 3 Q. By whom are you employed, Mr. Meyer and what is your position?
- 4 A. I am employed by Cartwright Creek as the Vice President of Operations.
- 5 Q. Please briefly describe your education and experience background.
- 6 A. I have a Bachelor's Degree in Air and Water Resource Engineering from the
 7 University of Illinois at Chicago and a Masters Degree in Environmental
- 8 Engineering from the Illinois Institute of Technology in Chicago. I hold
- 9 Professional Engineering Licenses in eight states, including Tennessee. In
- addition, I have a Biological/Natural Systems wastewater operators license and a
- Grade II Wastewater Collecting System license in the State of Tennessee. I have
- over 30 years of experience in design, construction, and operation of wastewater
- treatment, pollution control, hazardous waste management, and recycling/reuse
- 14 facilities.
- 15 Q. Who are the owners of Cartwright Creek, and what are their addresses.
- 16 A. The majority interest (90%) of Cartwright Creek is owned by Sheaffer
- 17 International, LLC. Their address is 800 Roosevelt Road, Suite 214B, Glen
- Ellyn, IL, 60137. A minority interest (10%) of Cartwright Creek is retained by
- the previous owners of the system.
- 20 Q. Please describe the area known as Stillwater that Cartwright Creek proposes
- 21 to service.
- 22 A. Stillwater is located south of the Triune area in Williamson County, near the
- intersection of Horton Highway and Patton Road. This property is owned and being
- developed by Eagle Ridge Investments, LLC (the "Developer"). The current site plan is
- composed of approximately 500 single family lots surrounding an 18 golf course and
- 26 clubhouse facility.

Q. Does a need presently exist for a wastewater provider at Stillwater?

Page 1 Meyer, Direct

1	A.	Yes. As mentioned in our Petition, Stillwater is presently without a wastewater
2		provider. Neither Williamson County nor any of the local utility districts or
3		municipalities intend to provide wastewater service to this area. As a result, the
4		only wastewater alternative for Stillwater, apart from Cartwright Creek, would be
5		individual septic tanks which would be harmful to the environment in this area.

6 Q. Mr. Meyer, what is the purpose of your testimony in this case?

- 7 A. The purpose of my testimony is to present information to the TRA on the
 8 managerial, financial, and technical capabilities of Cartwright Creek to provide
 9 service to Stillwater.
- 10 Q. What type of wastewater system will Cartwright Creek be operating at Stillwater.
- Cartwright Creek will be operating a Sheaffer Wastewater Reclamation and 12 A. Reuse facility that will be constructed on property within the PGA 5 and will 13 14 serve the Stillwater Development as well as other properties in the region. The Sheaffer System will treat the wastewater to a high quality utilizing a patented, 15 16 highly aerated, deep treatment cells. After filtration and disinfection, the reclaimed water will be land applied. While dedicated and permitted irrigation 17 18 area will be provided within the Stillwater Development, it is Cartwright Creek's 19 and the Developer's intent to reuse most, if not all, of the reclaimed water for 20 irrigation of the Stillwater golf course.
- Q. Didn't Cartwright Creek already receive authority from the TRA to provide service to the area designated as Planned Growth Area (PGA) 5 in Williamson County? If so, why is the Company submitting this Petition for an amendment to its existing CCN?
- 25 A. Yes. Cartwright Creek received authority from the TRA to provide service to 26 PGA 5 on July 12, 2005 in Docket 04-00358. However, while the regional 27 wastewater treatment plant that the Company plans to build will be entirely within

- PGA 5, the first customer for this facility, the Stillwater development, lies just outside the boundary of PGA 5. This Petition was necessary in order for us to install the collection lines from Stillwater to the regional wastewater treatment plant in PGA 5.
- Mr. Meyer, does Cartwright Creek possess the managerial capabilities to operate a wastewater utility?
- A. Yes. Cartwright Creek, along with its outside consultants and contractors, has the managerial capability to provide wastewater utility services. Cartwright Creek's parent company as well as myself have successfully managed other wastewater utilities. In addition, Cartwright Creek has contracted with WHN Consulting to provide it with the regulatory and accounting expertise that it will need to carry out its managerial duties.
- 13 Q. Mr. Meyer, please describe the <u>financial</u> capabilities of Cartwright Creek.
- A. Through its owners, Cartwright Creek possesses the financial capability to provide wastewater utility service. Naturally, without proper financial capability, the wastewater infrastructure couldn't be built in the first place. However, Cartwright Creek has also secured a letter of credit to assure the continued performance of wastewater service.
- 19 Q. Mr. Meyer, please describe the <u>technical</u> capabilities of Cartwright Creek.
- A. Cartwright Creek, along with its outside consultants and contractors, has the technical capability to provide wastewater utility services. I currently hold the operation licenses required for both the wastewater treatment and collection systems. In addition, it is our intent to hire an additional wastewater operator for the above-described wastewater reclamation and reuse system at Stillwater.
- 25 Q. Does this conclude your testimony?
- 26 A. Yes, it does.
