

RE: MLGW & Memphis Networx

As you are aware, Memphis Light Gas & Water and Memphis Networx were scheduled to appear before the House State & Local Government Committee on Tuesday, January 29, 2008.

Because the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (TRA), acting in its quasi-judicial role, is conducting an open investigation of the above mentioned entities regarding related issues, it would be improper for the TRA to comment or make statements in advance of its hearing and rendering a decision on the merits.

Accordingly, this scheduled appearance has been postponed until the completion of the pending investigation. After the TRA has completed its investigation and submitted its findings, the meeting will be rescheduled, if deemed necessary.
