ORDER DISMISSING PROCEEDING WITHOUT PREJUDICE

This matter came before the Hearing Officer upon a request, filed by AT&T Tennessee ("AT&T") on November 16, 2007, that this proceeding be dismissed without prejudice. The request states that "AT&T Tennessee does not intend to pursue approval of this tariff at this time." In its request, AT&T specifically reserves the right to refile this tariff or to file a new Directory Assistance ("DA") tariff. By AT&T's use of the preceding language, this Hearing Officer finds and concludes that the portion of the DA tariff, No. 2007-0283 filed by AT&T on August 10, 2007, which was suspended until November 19, 2007 by action of the Directors at the August 20, 2007 Authority Conference, has been withdrawn by AT&T.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

AT&T Tennessee's request that this matter be dismissed without prejudice is granted, and this docket is hereby closed.
