
ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DISMISS WITH PREJUDICE


This matter came before Chairman Eddie Roberson, Director Pat Miller and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority, the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on October 8, 2007 for consideration of the request of Turnberry Homes, LLC, for expedited relief. On October 4, 2007, the parties, Turnberry Homes, LLC and King's Chapel Capacity filed an *Agreed Order of Dismissal with Prejudice* stating that the matters in controversy in this docket have been amicably resolved and that this docket should be dismissed with prejudice. The panel voted unanimously to accept the *Agreed Order* as a motion to dismiss with prejudice and to grant the motion as such.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDER THAT:

1. The *Agreed Order of Dismissal with Prejudice*, attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**, is accepted and incorporated as if fully rewritten herein.
2. This matter is dismissed with prejudice, and this docket is hereby closed.
