Dear Gary:

In response to your January 11, 2008 decision, "Order Resolving Objections to Discovery Requests," Aeneas presently intends to file both a petition for reconsideration and, in the alternative, an interlocutory appeal of your order to the Authority.

In your decision, you have granted, in advance, permission for Aeneas to file such an appeal (see TRA Rule 1220-1-2-.06(6)) and state that "[i]f an appeal is taken, the December 7, 2007 procedural schedule in this docket is suspended pending the Authority's disposition of such an appeal."

The deadline for filing a petition to reconsider or an appeal to the Authority of your January 11 order is January 28, 2008, (see T.C.A. §§4-5-315 and 317) and Aeneas is currently preparing those documents for filing.

Under the December 7 procedural schedule, the parties' responses to discovery are due on January 18, 2008. Since Aeneas is appealing your order, however, it is Aeneas' understanding that the procedural schedule is now suspended pending the outcome of that appeal.
