


**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Director Eddie Roberson, Director Kenneth C. Hill and Director Sara Kyle of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on August 23, 2010. Syniverse Technologies, Inc. (the "Company") originally filed an Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide competing local telecommunications services, including facilities-based and resold local exchange, exchange access and interexchange telecommunications services in Tennessee on September 6, 2007. During a Hearing held on November 1, 2007, the Hearing Officer found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On June 30, 2010, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority, stating that it has no customers or revenues in Tennessee. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.¹

¹ The Company was granted authority to resell local and interexchange long distance private line data transport telecommunications services in Tennessee on November 10, 2003 in Docket No. 03-00549 under the name TSI Telecommunications Network Services, Inc. A name change to Syniverse Networks, Inc. was approved by the TRA on September 13, 2004 in Docket No. 04-00214, followed by the TRA's approval of a name change to Syniverse Technologies, Inc. on July 11, 2005 in Docket No. 05-00158. The authority granted to the Company in Docket No. 03-00549 was cancelled at the Company's request at the August 23, 2010 Authority Conference.
