
ORDER SETTING DEADLINE FOR FILING
MOTIONS TO COMPEL DISCOVERY AND RESPONSES THERETO

This matter is before the Hearing Officer upon the April 22, 2009 filing of *Chattanooga Gas Company's Objections to CAPD's Third Discovery Requests ("Objections")* with the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA" or the "Authority"). The procedural schedule adopted by the Hearing Officer on March 2, 2009 sets a Status Conference on May 4, 2009 and requires the responses of Chattanooga Gas Company ("CGC") to the third round discovery requests of the Consumer Advocate and Protection Division of the Office of the Attorney General ("Consumer Advocate") on May 12, 2009.

To maximize the efficiency and effectiveness of the Status Conference, the Hearing Officer orders that if, after the Consumer Advocate has attempted in good faith to amicably resolve the discovery objections of CGC, such disputes remain between the parties requiring a resolution by the Hearing Officer, the Consumer Advocate shall file a detailed motion for an order compelling discovery **no later than 2:00 p.m. CST on Monday, April 27, 2009**. In such event, CGC may thereafter file a response to the motion by **2:00 p.m. CST on Thursday, April 30, 2009**. To the extent deemed necessary by the Hearing Officer, oral argument concerning the

disputed discovery requests and related filings shall be heard during the Status Conference on May 4, 2009. The Hearing Officer will notify the parties of the commencement time for the Status Conference in a separately issued Notice of Status Conference.

BE IT HEREBY ORDERED.
