Atmos Energy Marketing, LLC ("AEM"), by and through counsel, hereby responds to the First Set of Discovery Requests of Stand Energy Corporation ("Stand").

Confidential Information

General Objections

AEM, rather, responds to the discovery requests in accordance with Rules 26, 33, and 34 of the Tennessee Rules of Civil Procedure and Tenn. Comp. R. & Reg. 1220-1-2-.11. Without waiving this general objection,

and subject to more specific objections set forth below, AEM responds to Stand's discovery requests as follows:

INTERROGATORIES

1. In Case No. RM08-2-000, "FERC seeks public comment on a proposal to require both interstate and certain major non-interstate pipelines to post on a daily basis capacity, scheduled flow information and actual flow information. The proposal would facilitate transparency of price and availability of natural gas providing a complete picture of daily supply and demand information. . ." December 20, 2007 FERC News Release.

What is AEM's position regarding FERC's proposed rule on pipeline posting requirements?


RESPONSE: AEM objects to this interrogatory on the grounds that it seeks information that is neither relevant nor reasonably calculated to lead to the discovery of admissible evidence. Without waiving these objections, AEM's response is that it has not taken a position regarding FERC's proposed rule on pipeline posting requirements.

Identify the Person(s) Responsible for providing the response: AEM objects to this interrogatory on the grounds that it seeks information protected by the attorney-client privilege and the attorney work product doctrine. 


