ORDER GRANTING THE MOTION OF SOUTHSTAR ENERGY SERVICES LLC D/B/A GEORGIA NATURAL GAS TO WITHDRAW AS INTERVENOR

This docket came before the Hearing Officer upon the filing of the *Motion of SouthStar Energy Services LLC d/b/a Georgia Natural Gas to Withdraw as Intervenor* filed by SouthStar Energy Services LLC d/b/a Georgia Natural Gas ("SouthStar") on November 26, 2007. In the motion, SouthStar explains that it has "determined that the cost to participate actively as a party in this proceeding is not justified by SouthStar's current business activity on the Atmos system." To date, no responses to the motion have been filed.² No party has objected to the motion and I know of no reason to deny the motion; therefore, it is my opinion that the motion should be granted.
