TO THE INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT


This matter came before Chairman Eddie Roberson, Director Sara Kyle and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on December 3, 2007 to consider the Petition for approval of the amendment to the interconnection agreement negotiated between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. and XO Communications Services, Inc. filed on October 19, 2007.¹

Based upon a review of the amendment, the record in this matter, and the standards for review set forth in 47 U.S.C. § 252, the Directors made findings consistent with those in the *Order Denying BellSouth's Motion to Reject Certain Provisions of Interconnection Agreement and Approving Interconnection Agreement, as Amended* issued on August 29, 2000 in Docket No. 98-00123 and unanimously granted the Petition.
