**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Vice Chairman David F. Jones, Director Kenneth C. Hill and Director Robin Bennett of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on April 20, 2015. An Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide competing local telecommunications services, including facilities-based, resold local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services, in Tennessee was filed by Nexus Communications, Inc. ("Nexus" or the "Company") on October 18, 2007. During a Hearing held on December 5, 2007, the Hearing Officer found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On January 9, 2015, the Authority received a request from Nexus to cancel its CCN, stating that it would no longer provide telecommunications services in Tennessee after April 16, 2015. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its CCN.
