

REQUEST:

Provide a listing of action taken by the respective state commissions in all nine states in the former BellSouth operating territory regarding the transfer of SBC Long Distance, LLC d/b/a AT&T Long Distance, LLC ("SBC LD") business local exchange customers.

RESPONSE: SBC Long Distance, LLC d/b/a AT&T Long Distance, LLC provides local exchange service to business customers in four (4) states in the former BellSouth operating territory - Florida, Georgia, Tennessee, and North Carolina.

> Florida - Joint petition of SBC Long Distance, LLC d/b/a SBC Long Distance d/b/a AT&T Long Distance, TCG South Florida, and BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida d/b/a AT&T Southeast for waiver of Rule 25-4.118, F.A.C., for migration of business local service customers was filed on November 16, 2007. The Florida Public Service Commission has not yet taken action on this matter. (Docket No. 070692-TP)

> Georgia - No approval by the Georgia Public Service Commission is required. AT&T Georgia filed notice outlining its plans with the GPSC on November 14, 2007. (Docket No. 18839-U)

> North Carolina - A Joint Request for Approval of Transfer of Local Business Service Customers from SBCLD dba AT&T LD to its Affiliate AT&T NC and of Service Discontinuance was filed on November 14, 2007. The North Carolina Utilities Commission has not yet taken action on this matter. (Docket P-638, Sub 5)
