Dear Ms. Sanders:

CLEC applicants are required, by statute, to demonstrate their managerial, financial and technical abilities to provide the services for which they seek authority. To assist the Authority in its review of Stellar Nordia Services, LLC's application for Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to provide competing local exchange telecommunications services in Tennessee, you are requested to provide the following information:

1) T.C.A. § 65-4-125 states that, "by September 1, 2000, all telecommunications service providers subject to the control and jurisdiction of the authority, except those owners or operators of public telephone service who pay annual inspection and supervision fees pursuant to § 65-4-301 (b) or any telecommunications service provider that owns and operates equipment facilities in Tennessee with a value of more than five million dollars (\$5,000,000), shall file with the authority a corporate surety bond or irrevocable letter of credit in the amount of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) to secure the payment of any monetary sanction imposed in any enforcement proceeding, brought under this title or the Consumer Telemarketing Protection Act of 1990, by or on behalf of the authority."

Please provide a \$20,000 corporate surety bond or irrevocable letter of credit. This bond or letter of credit will be verified by the Authority prior to consideration for authority.


2) The application states, on page 4, that "since 2005, Stellar has served as the principal U.S. call center contractor for GoAmerica's parent company, GoAmerica, Inc., with respect to Internet protocol ("IP") relay services." Please provide information regarding Stellar Nordia's wireline relay experience in the United States.

3) Please provide information on service metrics in regard to Stellar Nordia's wireline relay services in the state of California.

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In an attempt to comply with the request for expedited approval of the application of Stellar Nordia, the Tennessee Regulatory Authority requests that this information be provided on or before November 19, 2007. In accordance with TRA Rules, please submit either (1) thirteen written copies of your response or (2) four written copies and an electronic version and reference docket number 07-00254 on the correspondence.
