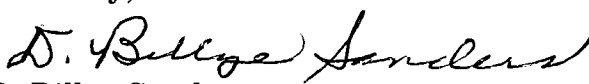

**STELLAR NORDIA'S RESPONSES TO THE DATA REQUESTS OF THE
TRA STAFF, DATED NOVEMBER 16, 2007**

1. T.C.A. §65-4-125 states that, "by September 1, 2000, all telecommunications service providers subject to the control and jurisdiction of the authority, except those owners or operators of public telephone service who pay annual inspection and supervision fees pursuant to §65-4-301 (b) or any telecommunications service provider that owns and operates equipment facilities in Tennessee with a value of more than five million dollars (\$5,000,000), shall file with the authority a corporate surety bond or irrevocable letter of credit in the amount of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) to secure the payment of any monetary sanction imposed in any enforcement proceeding, brought under this title or the Consumer Telemarketing Protection Act of 1990, by or on behalf of the authority."

Please provide a \$20,000 corporate surety bond or irrevocable letter of credit. This bond or letter of credit will be verified by the Authority prior to consideration of authority.

RESPONSE:

Stellar Nordia LLC has made arrangements for a \$20,000 bond, however, it will not be executed until November 20, 2007. The original will be hand served on the TRA on November 21, 2007 as soon as it is received by counsel.

2. The application states, on page 4, that "since 2005, Stellar has served as the principal U.S. call center contractor for GoAmerica's parent company, GoAmerica, Inc., with respect to Internet protocol ("IP") relay services." Please provide information regarding Stellar Nordia's wireline relay experience in the United States.

RESPONSE:

Since 2005, Stellar Nordia's sister company, Nordia, Inc., has served as one of only three authorized relay call center providers in the State of California. Pursuant to the company's California relay contract, Nordia provides Voice, teletypewriter ("TTY"), voice carry over ("VCO"), hearing carrier over ("HCO"), American Standard Code for Information Exchange ("ASCII") and speech-to-speech ("STS") relay services in both English and Spanish. The total volume of monthly session minutes now handled by Nordia in California (approximately 206,000 minutes, as of September 2007) is almost double that anticipated in Tennessee based on recent information supplied by Verizon, the incumbent relay provider.

During the three years which Nordia has been providing relay services in California, the state has regularly acknowledged the company's satisfactory performance. For example, in 2006, the director of the Public Utility Commission's (PUC's) Telecommunications Division provided Nordia a letter of recommendation which noted that Nordia had been "proactive" in responding to consumer suggestions. The PUC also observed that while the company had provided California relay service "for a relatively short period of time, its past and present experience has prepared it for serving" the state. See Attachment A.

In addition, in June 2007, the state confirmed that in response to the subpar relay service provided by one of its competitors, regulators would be redirecting an additional proportion of 711 traffic to Nordia. See Attachment B. This action signaled a further vote of confidence in Nordia's relay services by the State of California. In October, 2007 Nordia's California relay contract was assigned to Stellar Nordia.

3. Please provide information on service metrics in regard to Stellar Nordia's wireline relay services in the state of California.

RESPONSE:

Appended as Attachment C are day-by-day California Relay Service metrics for January to October 2007. The metrics show the Average Speed of Answer (ASA) for all the calls which Nordia now handles (Voice, TTY, VCO, HCO, ASCII, STS). The state ASA requirement is 3.3 seconds for all TRS modalities excepting STS, for which the ASA is 7 seconds.

Dear Ms. Rousseau;

This letter amends the traffic reallocation amounts identified in the second and third paragraphs of the CPUC's letter to Nordia dated May 24, 2007, as follows:

Based on the original allocation of traffic from the RFP evaluation, 75.00% of the original Arvato traffic allocation will be direct to MCI, and an additional 24.55% of the Sprint DDTP allocated traffic will be redirected to MCI, while 25.45% of the Sprint DDTP allocated traffic will be redirected to Nordia. This will result in MCI receiving 46.62% of the allocated CRS traffic, Nordia receiving 35.55%, and Sprint receiving 17.83%. These revised percentages of DDTP traffic do not include traffic for which consumers have selected a vendor via CRS Choice Forms, traffic directly dialed to a specific vendor via a vendor's 800 numbers, or CapTel traffic. This reallocation of CRS traffic previously allocated to Sprint may or may not be considered permanent at the CPUC's discretion.

The revised traffic allocations are effective at 7:00 AM PDT on July 9, 2007. The CPUC appreciates Nordia's agreement to the above modifications.
