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
**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY  
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**


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This matter came before the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority") at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on February 13, 2012. An Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide competing local telecommunications services in order to act as a call center subcontractor for GoAmerica Relay Services Corp. ("GoAmerica") with respect to GoAmerica's provision of intrastate telecommunications relay services in Tennessee was filed by Stellar Nordia Services, LLC (the "Company") on November 14, 2007. During a Hearing held on December 3, 2007, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. A name change to Stellar Relay, LLC was approved by the Authority on August 23, 2010 in Docket No. 10-00058. On January 9, 2012, the Authority received a request from the Company to cancel its CCN.<sup>1</sup> Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its CCN.
