

Comes now Lynwood Utility Corporation (Lynwood) and files this Response to the Data Request dated November 29, 2007 in this matter.

1. Provide a signed verification from Lynwood verifying that the information contained in the Petition is true and correct to their knowledge, information, and belief.

RESPONSE: Lynwood is obtaining a revised commitment letter from Tennessee Commerce Bank to extend the commitment of the loan and letter of credit to March 31, 2008. As soon as this revised commitment letter is received, Lynwood will submit an amendment to the Petition and the verification requested in Data Request No. 1.

2. What is the term of the \$250,000 line of credit?


RESPONSE: The \$250,000 line of credit is for a one year term. Lynwood anticipates that it will request that the \$250,000 line of credit be renewed annually, but the extension of the line of credit at the end of the first year will be at the discretion of Tennessee Commerce Bank.

3. What is the outstanding principal amount on the \$1,000,000 promissory note with Tennessee Contractor's, Inc.?

RESPONSE: \$950,000.00
