The rate changes proposed herein are filed in conjunction with the approved United Telephone-Southeast, Inc. d/b/a Embarq 2007 Annual Price Regulation Filing, which included the calculation of Embarq's 2007 Price Regulation Index (PRI) and Service Price Index (SPI) in Docket 07-00220.

Special access rate increases are proposed for Voice Grade Service, Digital Data Service, and certain High Capacity Services.

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Rate increases are also proposed for residence and business Local Measured Service, Residence Budget Service, Custom Calling and ExpressTouch features, Privacy ID, certain Restriction Service and Centrex Service options, Loop Treatment Equipment, and for various components of United TransLink, DigiLink, LightLink, and SwitchLink. This filing also proposes an increase in the Directory Assistance Service rate with a reduction in the number of allowances for directory assistance inquiries. The monthly rate for single line residence and business Incoming Billed Number Screening is reduced under this filing.


A number of the rate changes proposed in this filing are resulting in a single rate applicable for business and residence services. In those instances, the "business" and "residence" designations are being deleted, along with the duplicated rate, for simpler rate presentation and standardization.

Text changes are intended to clarify rates and availability of certain services for which the prior use of "N/A" was used alternatively to mean either "service not available" or "no charge" on certain pages for which rate changes are proposed. Occurrences where N/A previously meant "no charge" have been revised to "\$0.00," while use of N/A elsewhere in the tariff has been defined as "not available."

Included in this filing are proprietary supporting work papers confirming that these changes are compliant with the Price Regulation Plan of United Telephone-Southeast, Inc. as specified in T.C.A. 65-5-109. Public notice of these changes has been placed in newspapers throughout the Company's Tennessee territory, a copy of which is attached.

PUBLIC NOTICE
EMBARQ PROPOSED TARIFF CHANGES

EMBARQ has filed changes with the Tennessee Regulatory Authority in accordance with the requirements of the local Company's price regulation plan. These tariff changes involve increases to certain access lines and optional services. The tariff changes are scheduled to become effective December 19, 2007. A complete copy of the proposed tariff changes is on file with the Tennessee Regulatory Authority and is open to public inspection. Residential Measured Access Line customers will experience an increase in the monthly access line rate as follows:
Residential Measured Access Line is increasing to \$16.09
Residential Measured Access Line – Rotary is increasing to \$21.51
Residence Budget Service is increasing to \$9.11

Business Measured Access Line* customers will experience an increase in the monthly access line rate as follows:
Business Measured Access Line is increasing to \$29.95
Business Measured Access Line – Rotary is increasing to \$50.95

Key Measured Access Line – Rotary is increasing to \$50.95
Key Measured Access Line – Non-Rotary is increasing to \$50.95

PBX Measured Access Line – Non-Rotary is increasing to \$50.95
PBX Measured Access Line – Rotary is increasing to \$50.95

*Business customers subscribing to Term Discount Plans receive a 10% or 15% discount for a 2 or 3 year commitment, respectively. Discounts are applied to the proposed rates for Business Individual Lines, Key Trunks and PBX Trunks listed above.

Custom Calling Services (Business and Residence) will experience increases as follows:
Incoming Billed Number Screening is decreasing to \$1.00
Three Way Calling - Per Use (Usage Sensitive) is increasing to \$1.25
Call Forward Busy-Fixed, Call Forward No Answer-Fixed, Call Forward Busy-Customer Programmable, and Call Forward No Answer-Customer Programmable will all increase to \$2.00 per month
Call Forwarding – Fixed, Hot Line, Warm Line, Speed Dial 8, Call Forwarding, Three Way Calling, SignalRing Plus, Call Waiting ID, and Three Way Calling with Transfer (Business only) will increase to \$5.00 per month.
Speed Dial 30 is increasing to \$6.00 per month.

Custom Calling Features Packages will experience an increase in the monthly rate as follows.
