
**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard, Director Kenneth C. Hill and Director Robin Bennett of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority" or "TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on September 15, 2014. An Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide competing local and long distance telecommunications services in Tennessee was filed by EveryCall Communications, Inc. d/b/a Local USA d/b/a All American Home Phone ("EveryCall" or the "Company") on January 7, 2008. During a Hearing held on April 21, 2008, the Hearing Officer found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On April 21, 2014, the Authority received a request from EveryCall to cancel its CCN.¹ Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its CCN.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
