

November 14, 2008	Rebuttal testimony of parties
November 21, 2008	Exchange and Filing Exhibits
December 2, 2008	1:30 P.M. Pre-Hearing Conference
December 8-9, 2008 (or week thereof)	Proposed Hearing dates suggested by the parties; dates subject to confirmation by the assigned panel of directors

In addition, the parties previously agreed that if any issues or disputes arise regarding discovery, they will contact the Hearing Officer for resolution. After a Hearing date is determined, a Notice of Hearing will be issued.
