ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

This matter came before Director Kenneth C. Hill, Director Robin Bennett and Director David F. Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on May 5, 2014. An Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide competing local telecommunications services, including facilities-based and resold local exchange, exchange access and interexchange telecommunications services in Tennessee was filed by dPi Teleconnect, LLC ("dPi") on February 11, 2008. During a Hearing held on May 22, 2008, the Hearing Officer found that dPi had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. dPi later changed its name to Unity Telecom, LLC ("Unity" or the "Company").

On February 18, 2014, the Authority received a request from Unity to cancel its CCN.¹ Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its CCN.²

IT IS SO ORDERED.
