Petition of Tennessee Wastewater Systems, Inc. To amend its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity

Tennessee Wastewater Systems, Inc. ("TWSI") petitions the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA") to amend TWSI's Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to expand its service area to include a portion of Giles County known as Milky Way Farms. The project is located off of Milky Way Road in Giles County. The property includes parcels 30, 9.00, 9.04, and 30.02 on Tax Map 39 and parcel 16 on Tax Map 50, which are represented on the tax map enclosed (see attached "Exhibit A"). These parcels encompass approximately 1075 acres.

We are proposing to provide wastewater service to approximately 750-900 residential and commercial lots at Milky Way Farms. The initial wastewater system will be constructed to serve 100 residential lots in Phase 1 and Phase 2 at Milky Way Farms. Residential customers will be charged according to residential Rate Class 1, currently set at \$35.49 as of the date of this submittal. Commercial customers will be charged a rate commensurate with their usage volume and will follow the rate structure outlined in the commercial pages of our tariff. The initial wastewater system will be designed and constructed to serve approximately 100 lots (approximately 30,937 gallons per day) and can be expanded if needed. The TDEC application for a permit was submitted February 11, 2008. No contracts have been signed at this point. It is the intention of the parties that TWSI will own the collection, treatment, and dispersal system and will own a permanent easement on the property that the system occupies.

Also enclosed are letters from the Fairview Utility District and the Giles County Executive stipulating that neither of these entities will provide sewer service for these parcels. We have also enclosed a letter from the developer, Charles Ausburn of Milky Way Farms of Tennessee, LLC, requesting TWSI to be the public sewer utility provider for the project.

After approval, the construction of the system, which is comprised of watertight effluent collection, fixed film treatment, and subsurface drip dispersal, will take approximately 60 days to complete. The estimated value of the contribution in aid of the construction of the initial wastewater system is approximately \$450,000.00.

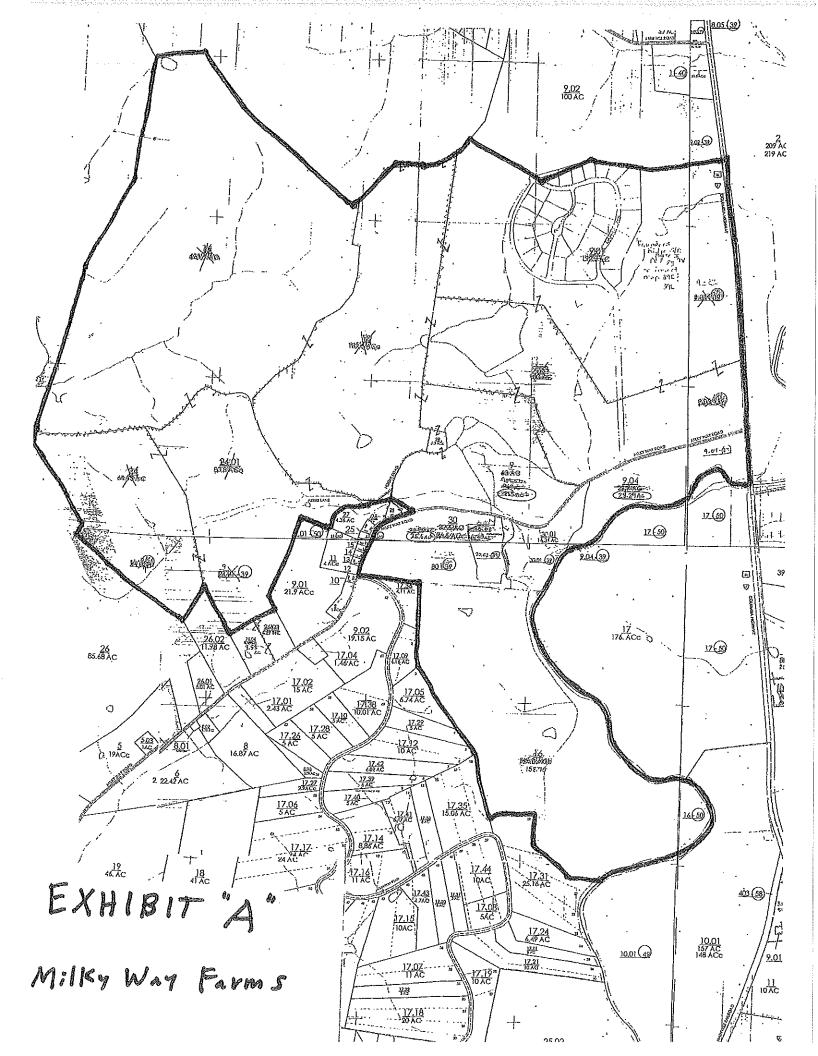

Promptly after the delivery of each Notice, the Lender hereby covenants and agrees to deliver, by wire transfer of immediately available funds, the Draw Amount to the Bank Account.

This letter of credit shall be deemed automatically renewed without amendment for successive one-year periods and may be canceled by the Lender by giving (30) days advanced written notice by certified mail of such cancellation to the Authority and the Company, it being understood that the Lender shall not be relieved of liability that may have accrued under this letter of credit prior to the date of cancellation.

Failure to renew this letter of credit shall allow the Authority to draw upon it without the necessity of the Authority being required to hold a hearing concerning the Principal's operation or Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity. In such an event and upon a directive from the Authority, the Lender hereby covenants and agrees to deliver by wire transfer of immediately available funds the maximum sum of this letter of credit to the Bank Account to enable the continued operation of the public wastewater utility.

The Lender Hereby represents and warrants that it is qualified and authorized to issue this letter of credit and is a bank designated by the Treasurer of the State of Tennessee as an authorized depository bank for the deposit of state funds.

Except as otherwise expressly stated, this letter of credit is subject to the Uniform Customs and Practice for Documentary Credit (1993 Revision) International Chamber of Commerce Publication No. 500 or any revisions thereto.
