Startec and Americatel have already provided a copy of the customer notice informing customers of the planned merger and assumption of Startec customers by Americatel. The Authority approved this notice on February 11, 2008, in the above-referenced docket and Startec and Americatel mailed the notice to Startec customers in Tennessee on February 25, 2008. Attached as Exhibit B is a copy of that customer notice.

4. Specify which services will be provided to customers under each name (Rule 1220-4-1-.08(2)(d)).

Americatel intends to use more than one business name to provide telecommunications services in Tennessee. Specifically, services provided under the Startec name include (i) presubscribed direct dial interexchange services; (ii) "dial around" casual calling services using the code: 1010 719; and "dial around" casual calling services using the code: 1016868. Services provided under the Americatel name will consist of "dial around" casual calling services using the code: 1010 123.
