ORDER GRANTING APPROVAL OF AN ASSUMED NAME

This matter came before Chairman Eddie Roberson, Director Tre Hargett, and Director Sara Kyle of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on June 23, 2008, upon the petition of NuVox Communications, Inc. ("NuVox, Inc." or "Company") to add an assumed name.

State Communications, Inc.. was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") as a reseller or telecommunications operator service provider to provide intrastate private line and telecommunications access service in Tennessee on August 4, 1998 in Docket No. 98-00330. On September 28, 1999, the Authority found that the company had met all TRA requirements and approved a name change to TriVergent Communications, Inc. ("TriVergent") in Docket No. 99-00661. On January 26, 2000, in Docket No. 99-00806, TriVergent was granted a CCN as a competing telecommunications service provider to expand its authority to provide a full array of telecommunications services including switchless interexchange telecommunications and all services provided by a local exchange carrier. On June 12, 2001, in Docket No. 01-00409, the Authority granted TriVergent approval to change its

name to NuVox Communications, Inc. On April 15, 2008, NuVox Communications, Inc. filed a Petition to add the assumed name of NuVox and to waive the customer notification letter.

Based upon careful consideration of the record of this matter and upon a finding that the Company has satisfied the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-1-.08, the panel voted unanimously to approve the name change.


