
Customer Notice.


To Customers of Kings' Chapel Capacity

On September 24th, 2008 Kings' Chapel Capacity filed a petition and revised tariffs with the Tennessee Regulatory Authority to recover its bonding costs for wastewater service imposed upon it by the Williamson County Planning Commission. Until now, these bonding costs have been largely subsidized by the developer of Kings' Chapel Subdivision. The developer has now asked Kings' Chapel Capacity to assume the responsibility for these bonding costs.

The tariffs filed by Kings' Chapel Capacity will cause the bond rate component of your monthly bill to increase from \$6.31 to \$21.06. This increase is designed to represent only the actual cost of bond funding, with any over- or under-collection of actual bond costs to be trued-up on an annual basis.

The Tennessee Regulatory Authority has now scheduled a hearing to consider the petition of Kings' Chapel Capacity on December 15th at the TRA's offices at 460 James Robertson Parkway, Nashville, Tennessee.
