¹ The original interconnection and resale agreement was filed and approved in Docket No. 03-00309 under the name United Telephone-Southeast, Inc. ("UTSE"). UTSE, a business formed in the State of Virginia, converted its incorporated ("Inc.") status to a limited liability company ("LLC") upon approval of the Virginia State Corporation Commission on November 9, 2007. The Tennessee Secretary of State issued a *Certificate of Authorization* to UTSE reflecting the LLC designation on December 18, 2007. In Tennessee, UTSE has been operating under the name of Embarg since 2006 and continues to do so. See, Letter of Edward Phillips dated May 16, 2008.
