


**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE
CUSTOMER OWNED COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE**

This matter came before Director Mary W. Freeman, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on September 21, 2009. Total Telephone Concepts, Inc. (the "Company") originally filed an Application to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") service within the State of Tennessee on June 20, 2008. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on July 14, 2008, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-2-.43 through 1220-4-2-.45 to provide COCOT service in Tennessee and approved the Application. On September 9, 2009, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority.¹ Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to cancel, by request, the authority of Total Telephone Concepts, Inc. to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.


